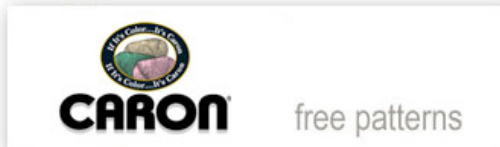

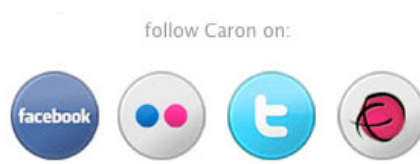


**Little Boy Blue Baby Blanket**
