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Fling Ponchini

with
FLING

TECHNIQUE USED: Crochet



EASY

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Approximately 26" wide by
10" long

MATERIALS

Caron International's Fling #0007 Twilight, 6 balls

One crochet hook size US K/10.5 (6.5 mm), or size to obtain gauge
Stitch markers

Tapestry needle (tn)

Sewing needle and matching thread

Two – 1" buttons

GAUGE

In single crochet, 8 sts = 4"/10 cm

STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)

Single crochet (sc)

NOTE

Ponchini may be worn two ways; either with the buttons in the Front and Back, or with a button at each shoulder.

HELPFUL

Place a marker between 2 center sc; count 25 to marker, then 25 from marker to end.



Wear our Fling Ponchini
two ways!

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BACK and FRONT (both alike)

Foundation Row: Ch 51.

Row 1: Beginning in second ch from hook, sc in second ch and in each ch across; turn—50 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 10" from beginning.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Join Back to Front:

* Overlap the upper corner of one edge of the Back diagonally over the corresponding upper edge of the Front. Using sewing needle and thread, sew button 1/2" from the corner edge, (see Diagram).

Measure 2 1/2" from the button toward the neck; using tn, tack the Front to the Back.

Repeat from * for opposite side.

Weave in ends.

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
