Spider Stitch Wrap

TECHNIQUE USED: Crochet



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Wrap measures approximately 25"/63.5 cm wide x 92"/233.5 cm long

MATERIALS

Caron International's Simply Soft

(100% acrylic; 6 oz/170 g, 315 yds/288 m skein): 4 skeins

Shown in: #9723 Raspberry.

One size US K/10.5 (6.5 mm) crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge.

Yarn needle

GAUGE

In pattern, 14 sts and 7 rows = 5"/12.5 cm.

Gauge is not critical for this project.

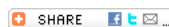
STITCHES USED

Chain (ch), double crochet (dc), half double crochet (hdc), single crochet (sc), slip stitch (slip st), treble

WRAP

Chain 73.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), dc in each remaining ch across, turn—71 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), sk next dc, 3 dc in next dc, [sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc] 3 times; *ch 11, sk next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, [sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc] 5 times; repeat from * once more; ch 11, sk next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, [sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc] 3 times, sk next dc, dc in last dc, turn—20 3-dc groups, and 3 ch-11 spaces.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in first dc, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 3 times, *ch 6, sc in next ch-11 sp, *ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 5 times; repeat from * once more, ch 6, sc in next ch-11 sp, ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 3 times, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, 3 dc in sp before first 3-dc group, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, *ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 4 times; repeat from * once more, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in sp following last 3-dc group, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in first dc, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, *ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 3 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 3 times; repeat from * once more, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 3 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, 3 dc in sp before first 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, *ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 5 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice; repeat from * once more, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 5 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in sp following last 3-dc group, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in first dc, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, *ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 7 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups; repeat from * 2 more times, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 8: Ch 3, 3 dc in sp before first 3-dc group, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, *ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 7 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next 2 ch-6 sps; repeat from * once more, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 7 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in sp following last 3-dc group, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 9: Ch 3, dc in first dc, 3 dc in sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, *ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 5 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp; repeat from * once more; ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 5 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 10: Ch 3, 3 dc in sp before first 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, *ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp; repeat from * once more, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in sp following last 3-dc group, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 11: Ch 3, dc in first dc, [3 dc in sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, *ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 3 times, 3 dc in

next ch-6 sp; repeat from * once more; ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 12: Ch 3, 3 dc in sp before first 3-dc group, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, *ch 11, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 4 times, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp; repeat from * once more, ch 11, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in sp following last 3-dc group, dc in last dc, turn.

Rows 13–112: Repeat Rows 3–12 ten times.

Rows 113–121: Repeat Rows 3–11.

Row 122: Ch 3, 3 dc in sp before first 3-dc group, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, *ch 5, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] 4 times, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp; repeat from * once more, ch 5, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups] twice, 3 dc in sp following last 3-dc group, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 123: Ch 3 (does not count as dc), dc in next 12 dc, [4 dc in next ch-5 sp, dc in next 18 dc] twice, 4 dc in next ch-5 sp, dc in next 12 dc, dc in last dc, turn – 73 dc. Do not fasten off.

Border

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), (hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in first dc, hdc in each dc across to last dc, (2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in last dc (corner made), do not work in top of turning ch; work 243 hdc evenly spaced across side edge to corner, (2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in corner; work 71 hdc evenly spaced across opposite side of foundation ch to corner, (2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in corner; work 243 hdc evenly spaced across opposite side edge to corner, (2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in corner; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—644 hdc and 4 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Round 2 (RS): With RS facing, join yarn with sc in a corner ch-1 sp to work along a long side edge, *ch 3, sk next 3 hdc, [sc in next hdc, ch 3, sk next 3 hdc] across to next corner ch-1 sp, sc in corner ch-1 sp; repeat from * 2 more times, ch 3, sk next 3 hdc, [sc in next hdc, ch 3, sk next hdc] across to next corner; join with slip st in first sc.

Round 3: (Sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-3 sp around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.
