## Pompom Scarf

with

**SIMPLY SOFT<sup>®</sup>**  
**Tweed**

**TECHNIQUE USED:** Crochet



One size

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Scarf measures approximately 4"  
wide by 68" long, excluding  
Pompoms

#### **MATERIALS**

[Caron International's Simply Soft Tweed](#) (98% Acrylic, 2% Rayon; 3 oz/85 g, 159 yds, 145 m)  
#0008 Grape, 2 skeins  
One size US I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook  
Tapestry needle  
Pompom maker (optional)

#### **GAUGE**

Gauge is not critical for this project.

#### **STITCHES USED**

Chain (ch)  
Double crochet (dc)

#### **NOTE**

Scarf is worked along both sides of the beginning chain, in rounds.

#### **SCARF**

Chain 160.

**Round 1:** Beginning in fourth ch from hook (3 skipped chains count as dc), work 2 dc in fourth ch, \* ch 1, skip next 2 ch, work 3 dc in next ch; repeat from \* across to last ch, in last ch work [ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 (first corner), 3 dc, ch 1 (second corner), 3 dc]; working along opposite side of beginning ch, \*\* ch 1, work 3 dc in same ch as 3-dc from opposite side; repeat from \*\* across to last ch, in last ch work [ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 (third corner), 3 dc, ch 1 (fourth corner)], join with a slip st to third ch of beginning ch-3. **Round 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), work 3 dc in first ch-1 space, \* ch 1, work 3 dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* around, working [ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 (corner), 3 dc] in each of next 3 corner ch-1 spaces, ch 1, in last corner ch-1 space work [ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 (corner), 2 dc], join with a slip st to third ch of beg ch-4. **Round 3:** Slip st in next ch-1 space, ch 3 (counts as dc), work 2 dc in same space, \* work 3 dc in next space; repeat from \* around, working [3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc] in each corner ch-1 space, join with a slip st to top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Using tn, weave in ends.

**Pompons:** Make four pompons, each 2" in diameter. Attach 2 pompons to each end of scarf. Make 4 pom poms.

### MACHINE WASH and DRY INSTRUCTIONS

Machine Wash: warm water, gentle cycle. Machine Dry: low heat, delicate cycle.
